Panel Challenges Factory Farming in Minnesota

In an unprecedented action, a coalition of national and area environmental, religious and community groups are joining forces to challenge and question the social justice, environmental and animal welfare impacts of factory farming in Minnesota. An event entitled, "Factory Farming in Minnesota - Time for a Change?" will occur on Saturday, February 4, 2017 at 10 am at Assisi Heights Spirituality Center, 1001 - 14th Street NW, Rochester, Minnesota.

The event is co-hosted by the Sisters of St. Francis - Assisi and Saint Mary's University of Minnesota/Cascade Meadow Wetlands and Environmental Science Center. The event is free and open to the public.

The event is the brainchild of Dr. Jeff Johnson, a frequent lecturer on the topic of animal welfare.
