DESCRIPTION: Great looking and performing Bear recurve. African Bubinga riser with "Autumn Tan" limbs. In 1970 the Tigercat was shortened to 58" (same as the Grizzly) and marketed as a "full pledged hunting bow". It was made on the same forms as the Grizzly, and is almost identical to the Grizzly (just a slightly wider back limb at the grip). Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. A few filled screw holes on side of riser and face limb (see pics on last page); No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing. A few faint superficial stress lines in the riser area, none of which extend into the working area of the bow. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. The limbs were stripped and revarnished with several hand rubbed coats of Tru-Oil. You can see "yellowed" old varnish around the saved decals. Decals are in very good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed); then taken to the range and test shot. It is an exceptional shooter. I've owned many vintage Bear bows over the years, and this one shoots as well as any Bear I've ever owned. Comes with a new Bear style rug rest and side plate, and a new string.
