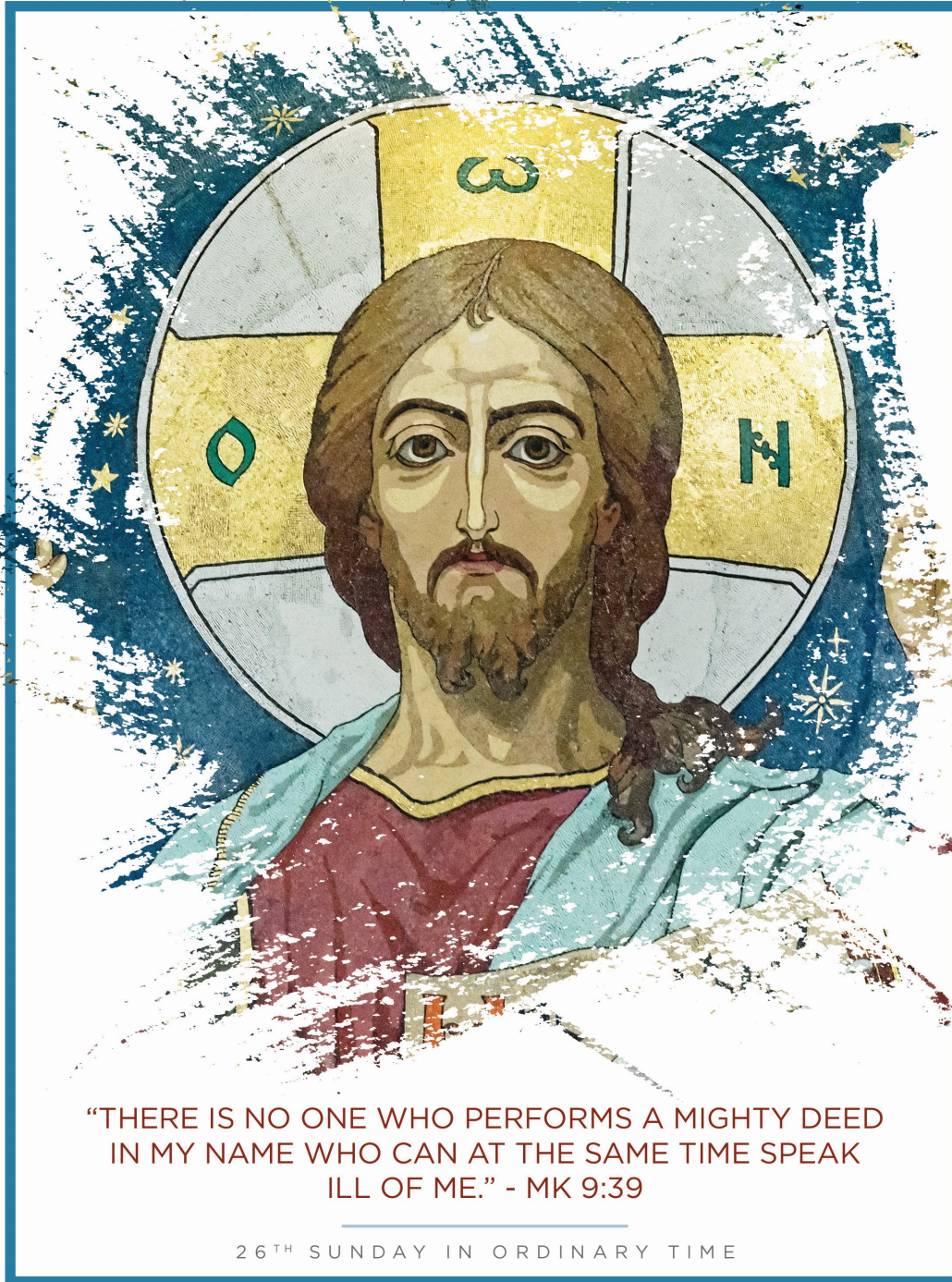

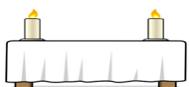

## Inner Peace in Divine Love: An online Ignatian Retreat begins Oct. 30

This virtual retreat program (open to all) invites participants to pray daily with selected Scripture passages, reflect on where and how God is leading us through these texts and through the events of daily life, and then meet once a week to share how God has been working. The event takes place on Saturday, Oct. 30, Nov. 6, Nov. 13 and Nov. 20 from 10–11:30 a.m. The cost of the online retreat is \$40 with an additional fee if participants choose to schedule an individual spiritual direction session via Zoom. 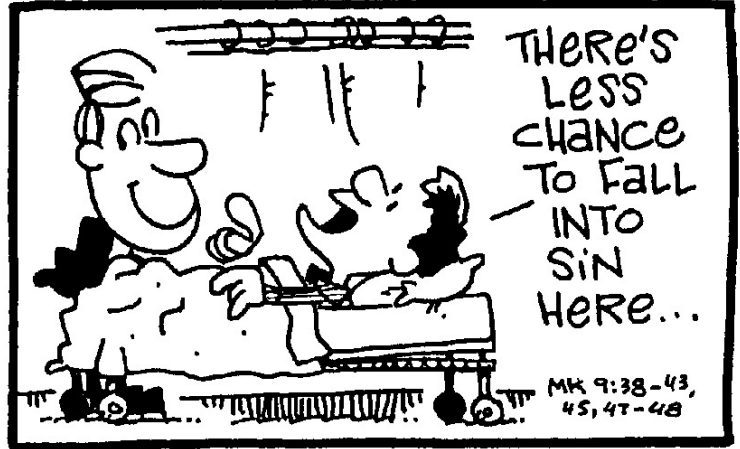
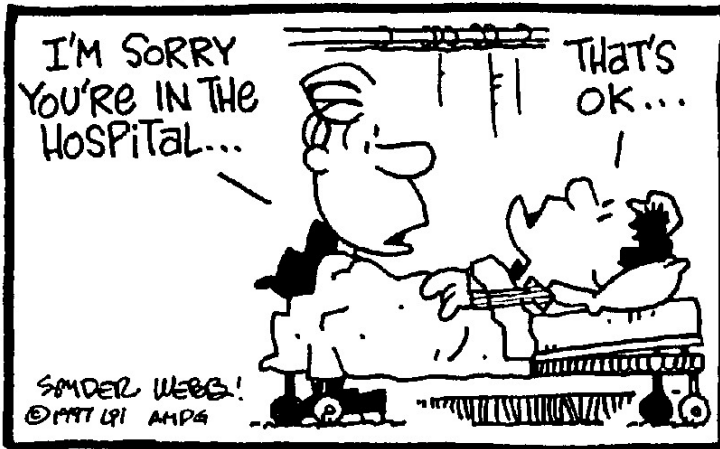

### INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Who are the little ones? They are the many and varied faces of people who see hope in Jesus' message about the Kingdom of God. They have come to believe that there is a different world to be had: a place where everyone has a home, all have an equal opportunity to share in God's bountiful gifts and blessings, where justice reigns, truth presides, and peace fills hearts. The little ones are those who may have left their former views behind, perhaps even their former lives to follow Jesus and believe in the Beatitudes as God's world vision. They are the poor, the marginalized, the women and men at the well, the Zacchaeus' looking for Jesus from a tree, the blind who want to see, and the lame who want to walk.
