ORDINANCE NO. 03 - 2017

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF JUPITER INLET COLONY, FLORIDA AMENDING CHAPTER 17 TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES BY AMENDING SECTION 17-6. PARKING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY. OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF JUPITER INLET COLONY, FLORIDA, TO PROVIDE THAT MOTOR VEHICLES MAY BE PARKED ONLY ON AN APPROVED DRIVEWAY OR PARKING AREA AND MAY NOT BE PARKED IN A YARD OR LANDSCAPED AREA; PROVIDING AUTHORITY TO CODIFY; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE, A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF JUPITER INLET COLONY, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. Chapter 17 TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES, Section 17-6 Parking on Private Property. of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Jupiter Inlet Colony, Florida is hereby amended to read as follows.

SECTION 17-6. Parking on Private Property.

It is unlawful to park a motor vehicle, as defined in Section 20-1 of this Code, in any portion of a yard or landscaped area on private property in a location between a structure and a public street except on an solid surface approved driveway or parking space area. consisting of asphalt, concrete, paver stones, stones or bricks or in a garage.

SECTION 2. Specific authority is hereby granted to codify and incorporate this ordinance into the existing Code of Ordinances of the Town of Jupiter Inlet Colony.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> Should any section or provision of this Ordinance or any portion thereof be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
