Closed for Statutory Holidays

The Preeceville Town Office and Town Shop holiday Hours are as follows:

Snow Removal and Parking

The Town of Preeceville would like to remind you to avoid shoveling or ploughing your snow on to the streets, back alleys, and sidewalks. Piling snow on to these areas causes extra work for the snow removal crew which delays other streets from being cleared. Snow piles also become packed and freeze, which may cause damage to the snow removal equipment. Also, please be reminded that vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than a 24-hour period and vehicles are not to be parked so that they are obstructing a sidewalk.

Dog Licenses

All Town of Preeceville Dog Licenses will expire on December 31st, 2022. Please ensure that your dog license(s) are renewed for the 2023 year. Not obtaining a license is an offense under Bylaw No.4 – 2022 of the Town. The fee for a dog license is \$10.00 for females not spayed and \$5.00 for females spayed and all males. The Town of Preeceville has passed a new animal control bylaw, all pet owners are encouraged to review the new bylaw to ensure you are aware of your responsibilities as a pet owner. The Town of Preeceville would also like to remind anyone with current town business licenses that come December 31st, 2022; all licences become void and must be renewed to be valid for the 2023 year.
