We are very excited to announce that two new scholarships have been permanently funded to benefit graduates of Touchet High School. Thank you Eileen Daniel and Bruce & Barbee Callander for your generous contributions and your support of our Touchet Educational Foundation scholarship programs!

Evelyn & Don Patterson Memorial Scholarship \$10,000

In the fall of 2019, this endowed scholarship was established in memory of Evelyn L. and Don E. Patterson. Evelyn (McCubbins) and Don were raised in the Touchet area (class of 1968 & '69) and married in 1970. Don passed away in 2004, Evelyn in 2016. This \$500 scholarship will be directed toward a student in the area of medical, veterinary, forestry, theology or the arts, which all were important interests of Evelyn and Don. It was set up by her sister, Eileen (McCubbins) Daniel, class of 1974. It will be available to award in spring 2021.

Callander Family Scholarship \$10,000

In December 2019, this endowed scholarship was established by Bruce & Barbee Callander, to benefit a deserving and qualified applicant. The Callander Family Scholarship was established in honor of the Dodd and Rea families and their one hundred forty years of farming and contributions to the Touchet community. Where do contributions to area of “greatest need” go?

Our policy has been to award a basic TEF Merit Scholarship to every senior that participates in our fundraising and submits a complete application by the deadline. Since 2012, that basic scholarship has been \$1,000 per student. Depending on class size, we have awarded \$11,000—\$26,000 just in basic scholarships. The fundraiser, memorial contributions, and general donations fund these basic scholarships.

Continuing Education (Junior Standing) Scholarships—due date May 15, 2020

Eligibility: junior standing or above, enrolled at an accredited four year college/university to complete an undergraduate or graduate degree, minimum 2.75 college GPA.

Class of 2019 (2nd Year) Scholarships—due date July 15, 2020

Eligibility: student enrolled at an accredited institution, have earned a minimum 36 college level credits (quarter) or 24 college level credits (semester), minimum 2.75 college GPA.
