Refund Policy: UTC has a No Refund Policy with exception of personal injury (doctor involvement), immediate family death, or when a trip is sold out. Only the trip leader can sell your spot. You would then be refunded the amount that you paid less a \$20 or \$20 service charge. Under no circumstances may a participant advertise their trip for sale. Full details and Terms of Participation on our website.

Roommate Policy: Double occupancy is standard on all trips. UTC attempts to honor roommate and rooming requests, but they are not guaranteed. Final room assignments are at the trip leader(s) discretion as room assignments changes

may be required up to the time of trip arrival. In some instances, trip participants may be assigned to room with a roommate they do not know or may have to share a bed (unusual but it has happened).
