

AN ORDINANCE REPLACING SECTIONS 717.15, 717.16, 717.17, 717.19, 717.21, 717.22, 717.23, 717.24, 717.25, and 717.26 OF ARTICLE 175 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WILLIAMSON, WEST VIRGINIA, WHICH SHALL BE REPLACED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

717.15 INSURANCE AGENTS.

No person, firm or corporation shall engage in selling of insurance within the corporate limits of the City, without first obtaining a license from the City nor shall a person continue to engage in such activity after his license has expired, been suspended or revoked. The annual license fee to be collected by the City for licenses issued under this section is fifty dollars (\$50.00).

717.16 INSURANCE COMPANIES.

- (a) Fire Insurance Companies. The annual license fee for a fire insurance company or association, or any other company or association issuing fire insurance policies or coverage against loss by fire shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00).
- (b) Casualty, and Other Companies. The annual license fee for casualty, liability, health, etc. and all other similar companies, shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00).
- (c) Life Insurance Companies. The annual license fee for a life insurance company shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00).

717.17 JUNK DEALERS OR THEIR AGENTS.

(a) Definitions.

- (1) "Junk" as used in this section, means old or scrap gold, copper, brass, rope, rags, batteries, paper, rubber, automobile parts, iron, steel and other old scrap ferrous or nonferrous metals.
- (2) "Junk dealers" includes all persons engaged in the business of buying or selling junk as defined in subsection (a)(1) hereof.
- (3) "Junk dealer's agents" includes all persons who buy or sell junk as defined in subsection (a)(1) hereof for or on behalf of a junk dealer, as defined in subsection (a)(2) hereof, but the term "junk dealer's agent shall not be construed to include any person regularly employed upon a salary by a regularly licensed junk dealer engaged in such business within the State.
- (4) "Itinerant junk collector" includes only such persons who gather junk from place to place with the aid of a cart or vehicle hand drawn or propelled, who have no fixed place of business.
- (5) "Nonresident junk dealer" or "nonresident junk dealer's agent" includes all persons who act as junk dealers or junk dealer's agents who are nonresidents of the State and all firms so engaged whose members are nonresidents of the State and all corporations which have not been admitted to hold property and transact business in the State.

- (b) Fees. The annual license fee to act as a resident junk dealer shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00); to act as a junk dealer's agent, fifty dollars (\$50.00); to act as a nonresident junk dealer or his agent who buys or solicits for the purchase of junk within the State, one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00); to act as an itinerant junk collector, fifty dollars (\$50.00).

717.19 THEATERS AND PUBLIC SHOWS.

The license fee for the operation of a theater, opera house or other permanent place for public shows shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00).

717.20 COLLECTION AGENCIES.

The annual license fee to engage in the business of a collection agency shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00). For the purposes of this section, solicitation by or

through an agent shall be considered to be engaging in the business of a collection agency.

717.21 BILLIARD, POOL AND BAGATELLE TABLES.

The annual license fee to keep or maintain a billboard, pool or bagatelle table, or table of like kind, for public use, where any charge is made for the use of the same, shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00); but if more than one of such tables be kept or maintained in the same building by the same person, the fee shall be fifteen dollars (\$15.00) for each additional one.

717.22 , BOWLING ALLEYS,

The annual license fee to keep or maintain a bowling alley for public use where any charge is made for the use of the same, shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00); but if more than one be kept and maintained in the same building by the same person, the fee shall be fifteen dollars (\$15.00) for each additional alley.

717.23 HOTELS, MOTELS AND BOARDING HOUSES.

Upon every hotel, motel and boarding house, there is imposed an annual license fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00).

717.24 RESTAURANTS.

Upon every restaurant doing business within the City there is imposed an annual license fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00).

717.25 SALE OF WEAPONS.

The annual license fee to sell or offer for sale pistols, revolvers, dirks, slingshots, billies, bowie knives, metallic or other false knuckles or other weapons of like kind, shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00).

717.26 RETAIL DEALERS IN TOBACCO.

The annual fee to sell at retail cigarettes, cigarette papers or wrappers, and cigars, tobacco, snuff and other preparations of tobacco shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00); and, to sell at retail cigars, tobacco, snuff and other preparations of tobacco other than cigarettes or cigarette papers or wrappers shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00). The giving away or furnishing of cigarette papers or wrappers in connection with the sale of tobacco, or other thing of value, shall be deemed to be a Sale thereof under the provisions of this section.
