It's November which means it's hunting season and that's a big deal in Pennsylvania...a really big deal. According to a 2019 report by the Congressional Research Service (R45667), Pennsylvania ranks 33rd in size (4,5306 square miles) but ranks 2nd (behind Texas) in the number of hunting licenses sold per year (973,339 average from 2015 through 2019). That means that Pennsylvania ranks #1 in the number of hunting licenses per square mile with an incredible 21.5 hunting licenses per square mile followed by Tennessee (16.9), Wisconsin (12.6), Michigan (12.4), and Maryland (11.8) to round out the top five. So, if you thought there's a lot of hunters out there, you were right. I hope everyone has a safe and productive hunting season.

York IWLA's annual Christmas party will be held on Tuesday, December 19th after a brief membership meeting, which will begin at 6:00 pm (not 7:00 as usual). Members are invited to bring a side or dessert. The club provides ham and turkey. Be sure to bring some cash for the juniors' gift auction. It's always a boatload of fun.




This years Judge Tobin Award
