The Annual Awards Banquet for the 1989 Fall Season AND 1990 Winter Season will be held on May 24, 1990 at Alex's Continental. Alex's is located on Route 725, a half mile west of I-75. The cocktail hour will begin at 6:00 pm with dinner being served at 7:00 pm. The menu will be served buffet style and will include Baked Ham, Roast Tenderloin and Baked Chicken. The DDA will provide BEER ONLY free of charge. If you wish to drink something besides beer a bar will be available to you at your expense. IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH OHIO LIQUOR LAWS, UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES IS ANYONE TO BRING ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ONTO THE PREMISES! We stress this because in the past members have been permitted to bring their own liquor, but this will not be possible this year. ANYONE FOUND WITH A ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE THAT IS NOT OBTAINED FROM ALEX'S WILL BE EXPELLED FROM THE BANQUET HALL.

After dinner is served there will be a short Board meeting followed by the election of the Vice President and four Trustees. Only DDA members will be permitted to vote. You must have your DDA Membership card in order to obtain a ballot. If you do not have your card, you will be able to obtain one at the door. We will then distribute the Awards for both the Fall and Winter Seasons which will be followed by entertainment provided by DJ Larry Viers of Spectrum Sounds.

In order for Banquet costs to remain at a minimum, Alex's requires that we provide them with the amount of people that will attend. We must do this no later than one week before the date of the Banquet. It is very important that you make a reservation only if you are fairly positive that you will attend. Once we have presented Alex's with the amount of attendance, we are required to pay for that amount of people whether or not they actually attend the Banquet. Over the past four years the DDA has paid a substantial amount of money for members that have made reservations but did not attend the Banquet. In order to offset some of these costs this year, the DDA has decided that a \$5.00 Reservation Deposit will be required for each member making a reservation. The \$5.00 will be returned to you at the door the night of the Banquet. If you do not attend the Banquet, the \$5.00 will not be returned.

If you wish to bring a guest (non member) the charge will be \$10.00 per guest. (This fee is non-refundable.) When filling out your reservation form you should include the amount of any quests along with \$10.00 per guest.

For those teams who did not receive an award this year, the DDA encourages you to come and enjoy yourself anyway. This Banquet is for **ALL** DDA members, not just the ones who are receiving an award!
