Historic Dam Trail

Sunday, June 10, was the opening ceremony and hike with approximately 70 attendees. PJ made introductory comments and presented an overview of the project at the trail head. Eric Weber and Elizabeth Sharpe spoke at locations at the dam site. Donations from the sale of brochures at \$2 each were \$68 and from the sale of WWTC caps, \$70. The donations will be used toward the project. We have approximately 200 brochures remaining to sell. Following a short discussion, it was suggested that the Library, Williamsburg Pharmacy and General Store might be locations where they could be sold. We will offer them for sale at the HLT Father's Day Hike.

2018 Budget

We purchased a grub hoe, rake, cordless drill replacement battery and an additional blade for the brush saw.

Horse Mountain Project

There was discussion of trail scouting for boundaries and features on the Williamsburg parcel and into the Hatfield parcel to develop a trail loop on the Williamsburg and adjoining Hatfield parcel. We also discussed a small trail head kiosk, signage and parking. GB will contact Jim Lemkin to schedule the hike so he could accompany us.
