Cost

Course Description

This course explores spiritual development as well as methods of discipleship practice in the church. Students will examine the biblical backgrounds of discipleship and the role of spiritual disciplines, accountability in spiritual growth, and community.

The best way to grow any ministry is to make disciples and work yourself out of a job. This course will also apply disciple-making on a personal basis, and develop a long-range plan for the local church in cooperation with church leadership.

Course Objectives

Upon the successful completion of this course, students should:

1. ... demonstrate understanding of the biblical mandate and models for discipleship.
2. ... be able to articulate how people grow in faith and practice in Christian life.
3. ... be able to apply the development of spiritual disciplines to the life of a believer.
4. ... demonstrate their ability to plan and design church practice for the development of discipleship.
5. ... be able to practice everyday relational disciple making skills.

Scriptural Bases for the Course

Ideal Participants for the Course

All Christians, especially Church Leaders

A primary responsibility for all believers is to make disciples who make disciples. Every Christian should be active in fulfilling his or her role in the church. Whatever those roles might be, the believers need to train others to do the job so well they are able in turn to train others to do the ministries. Every believer needs to work himself or herself out of a job on a regular basis. Humanly speaking, this sounds crazy. However, every great business leader knows this process is required to have a solid organization. (All students need to be at least 21 years old.)



Level of Difficulty

The courses offered at O.N.E. School within the ADVANCE program of Gateway are designed for the average adult to gain the equivalency of Bible College training taught at a reduced cost and set in a local context. The level of difficulty is post high school, but not necessarily at a Junior college level. At least three different levels of difficulty will be available for this semester:

- 1) the basic level works toward a certificate
- 2) the advanced level actually earns seminary credit at the Master's level, and
- 3) the easiest level where you audit the class and have no required assignments.
