District 25 Panel 66: DCM Report (Cort H.) 10-4-16

Welcome to our monthly District meeting.

- 1. Web-servant Report (from Deanie): As a follow up to last month's Report, Web-servant is currently continuing to use same webserver and will be present at November District Meeting with recommendations for next year, and next panel.
- 2. Along with the ADCM, the DCM attended 3rd Quarterly Area 59 Meeting, on Sunday, September 11th in Phoenixville, PA. Of note:
 - a. Convention Committee asks that GSRs and members register as soon as possible, especially roommate situations. Due to sufficient registration, cut-off for Registration at the Hotel has been moved back to October 17th. Also, if you register with the Hotel, **using the form**, the registration cost of \$299.00 covers all convention activities and meals, including the banquet dinner. A separate registration and moneys does not need to be sent to the EPGSA convention committee.
 - b. Alt. Delegate asks that the Districts try to get non-GSR volunteers for EPGSA, especially to assist with activities and duties during the Convention, when DCMs, ADCMs, and GSRs will be occupied with the convention and voting. Please register as a volunteer using the online form on the area website, www.area59aa.org, or contact the Alt. Delegate, Paul M., at alt-delegate@area59aa.org. As well, you can submit information to the DCM who can forward it to the Alt. Delegate.
 - c. The Delegate has organized a "Unity" 5K Walk/ Run at 6 AM on Sunday Morning. Please participate if you are so inclined!
 - d. The 2016 Final Report from the 66th Annual Meeting of the General Service Conference of Alcoholics Anonymous was handed out. I have dispersed them and have more. More can be obtained at the EPGSA Convention and can be found on the Area 59 website along with at the main AA website.
- 3. The DCM attended the EPGSA/ YPAA Share-A-Day (organized in part by newly relocated to District 25 member, Kelly F.), on Saturday, October 1st. Of note:
 - a. Many of the Area 59 and local Intergroup service reps. have been influenced and aided by the YPAA community and conferences. As well, more members identifying as YPAA affiliates are participating in the AA General Service Structure.
 - b. The Share-A-Day provided a lot of information and experience about the YPAA conventions, including the bidding process, hosting a conference, and post-conference insights and services. Most presenters identified the conference process as "service work," which connected them more deeply to AA and their service counterparts or community.
 - c. As well, there was an organized discussion on "Overcoming YPAA Misperceptions," which examined the perception that YPAA represents a separate or non-AA entity. Most presenters spoke to the idea that YPAA follows AA Traditions and Concepts for organizing, that it tries to compliment the General Service Structure (not take away from it), and that it provides a unique service to those who identify with or feel connected to the YPAA community.

- b. The deadline for the hotel reservation has been extended to **October 17th**, **2016**. Cost for the weekend, including registration, all convention activities, and all meals, including the Sat. Night Banquet, is \$299.
- c. This is an election year, and therefore it is important that participants, GSRs and DCMs, be present for the opening roll call, held at 8:45 AM. If not present at that time, members will not be able to vote. As well, the elections are for Area 59 positions, Delegate, Alt.-Delegate, Chairperson, Secretary, Treasurer, and Officer-at-Large. Those eligible for positions are current members of the Area Committee, including Area Officers and District Committee Members.
- 5. District 25 Elections next month, Tuesday November 1, 2016 (not to be confused with U.S. General Elections the following Tuesday ©).
 - a. G.S.R.: "General Service Representative. The Group contact with the General Service Office; voting member of the area assembly." For more information on the G.S.R.'s duties and qualifications, see Chapter 2 of *The A.A. Service Manual*, "The Group and Its G.S.R."
 - b. D.C.M.: "District Committee Member.An experienced G.S.R. elected by other G.S.R.s to represent the groups of the district in area committee meetings and to coordinate service activities in the district." "The D.C.M. is an essential link between the group G.S.R. and the area delegate to the General Service Conference. As leader of the district committee... the D.C.M. is exposed to the group conscience of that district. As a member of the area committee, he or she is able to pass on the district's thinking to the delegate and the committee." "Qualifications... [the D.C.M.] has usually served as a G.S.R. and is elected by other G.S.Rs.... should have enough sobriety (generally four to five years) to be eligible for election as delegate.... needs to have the time and energy to serve the district well." For more information on DCM duties and qualifications, see Chapter 3 of *The A.A. Service Manual*, "The District and the D.C.M."
 - c. A.D.C.M.: "The Alternate D.C.M... is a backup for the D.CM. If the D.C.M. resigns or is unable to serve for any reason, the alternate steps in.... Alternate committee members should be encouraged to assist, participate, and share in the D.C.M.'s responsibilities at district and area meetings."
 - d. Secretary: "The Secretary records the minutes at the [district] meetings and functions; prepares the minutes and distributes them...; [and] maintains current records [of District Information and G.S.R.s]."
