

Q1 Do you believe it is now safe to return to in-person instruction?





Q2 Do you feel well informed about what teaching will look like with students in the classroom?





Q3 Do you feel comfortable teaching in-person AND online in the same day?





Q4 Are you spending more or less time in daily preparation for Distance Learning lessons?





Q5 Do you feel you have enough preparation time to plan for both inperson and online instruction daily?





Q6 How many hours per week do you work when considering planning, teaching, contact, grading, etc?










