Information for Salem Indiana/Kentucky Invitational Rodeo

Check-In: Friday Evening, 5-8 pm Face covering is required for check-in

Please note that for this rodeo you will be asked to abide by the Indiana mandates regarding Covid-19. Face coverings are required in <u>outdoor public spaces when it's not possible to socially distance from people not in the same household</u>. Contestants will not be required to wear face coverings while competing, but for the safety of those around the arena, we recommend that they wear face coverings when not competing. Face coverings will NOT be provided by the association.

There will be hand sanitizer and wipes provided throughout the rodeo facility. Also, it is recommended that parents practice social distancing and/or face coverings while in the stands and/or arena.

If you have been directly exposed to anyone that has been tested for Covid-19 and pending results or tested positive for Covid-19 please use good judgment and do not attend the rodeo.

The Indiana High School Rodeo Association, the rodeo sponsors, SIJRA and Kalmbach Arena are not responsible for any illness that may occur as a result of the contestant or contestant's family participating in this rodeo.

This is a jackpot rodeo, so everyone will be entered in the jackpot. A portion of your entry fee will go into the jackpot fund.

Friday Evening:

There will be warm-up/practice barrels and poles for \$5 per run.

Shoot:

There will be a shoot on Saturday morning at the Livonia Conservation Club, 5853 S Possum Hollow Rd, Campbellsburg, IN 47108. Shooters will meet with Jeramy Byers at the Announcer's Stand at 7:30am to depart for the range. The conservation club is about 10 minutes from the arena.

Camping/Stalls:

This is a primitive site. There are no electric or water hookups, or shower facilities. There are NO stalls, so you will need to tie to your trailer or set up pens. Each family must clean up their site -- trash needs to be placed in the dumpster and manure and hay spread out over the ground.

There is a map of the grounds attached showing the designated camping and no parking areas.

Food and apparel vendors will be onsite. Concession will be provided by Penner Family Concessions. They will provide breakfast, lunch, and dinner. They provide an array of homemade baked goods, and combo meals. Their food is delicious. Concessions are located at the rear of the announcer's booth. Please support Penner Family Concessions.

The hosts have a designated student cheering section for all Contestants. Saturday night is Hawaiian night, so get in the spirit and come cheer on your teammates! Masks should be worn in this area.
