U. S. Coast Guard Cutter SANGAMON

The Western Rivers System of the United States (the Mississippi and its tributaries) requires our Coast Guard to mark some 15,000 miles of waterways with aids to navigation, and to maintain those aids.

Prominent among the critical Coast Guard facilities on the Western Rivers is USCGSTA East Peoria (next door to our convention center) with its brawny, busy, buoy-tending Cutter SANGAMON.

We will tour the Station and SANGAMON, as guests of the commanding officers of the Station, the Cutter, and the Peoria Flotillas of the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary.

Requirements: A government-photo identification card (state driver's license OK); no alcohol or firearms on your person; and you must be able to board the Cutter without assistance; wear rubber-soled shoes.

Assemble: 9:00 AM in hotel lobby. Look for Phil Aszling (in a CG Auxiliary polo shirt).

NOTE: Tour may be cancelled for security reasons, or if SANGAMON is on operations.
