Crop & Market Update

Shipping activity is starting to slow down as summer approaches. Oregon is having ideal weather to finish off the crop. We are very early at this stage and according to the old farmers, “early crop is a poor crop.” We will see what happens next month. The lower Columbia River basin will start to see some bluegrass going into the windrow on Monday/Tuesday. They are 10-12 days early over historical averages. Northern Minnesota/Southern Manitoba are seeing some much needed rain to help there crop along. They are a few days ahead but pretty close to average.

- Perennial Ryegrass:** Prices are stable.
- T.T. Tall Fescue:** Prices are stable.
- Kentucky Bluegrass:** Prices are stable with high performing varieties sold out.
- Hard Fescue:** Prices are strong.
- Creeping Red Fescue:** Prices are stable for improved types.
- Chewings Fescue:** Prices are stable.
- Sheeps Fescue:** Price is stable.
- Annual Ryegrass:** Prices are stable for now.
- Orchardgrass:** Prices are stable but supplies remain tight for all varieties
- Clover:** Crimson clover is strong.
- Highland:** Price is stable.
