The Lake Worth Art League is a 501(c)3, nonprofit member-based organization.

In 1941, the Palm Beach Art League had grown to the extent that it became necessary to separate into 16 satellite units throughout the county. Today, only two remain: the Norton Museum and the Lake Worth Art League. Founded by 30 members over 76 years ago in, what is now the Children's Room of the Lake Worth Public Library, the Lake Worth Art League continues to foster community involvement and appreciation of art while providing opportunities for artists of every skill level to explore, develop, and sell their creations.

SHOW YOUR WORK IN OUR GALLERY; COMPETITION AND SALES OPPORTUNITY

REGARDLESS OF YOUR EXPERIENCE OR SKILL LEVEL, YOU CAN SHOW YOUR 2D AND 3D ARTWORK IN OUR DOWNTOWN ARTIST'S EYE GALLERY!

- New shows every four weeks
- Artists Reception held for each show.
- Shows are professionally judged and ribbons and cash awards are given in Season. Entry Fees are minimal. There is a 3 piece maximum. Rules for Gallery shows must be followed.
- Summer show fees are reduced as they are usually not judged and no awards are given (subject to change). 5 piece maximum.
- Only a small percentage of the sale price of each item sold is retained by the Gallery
- Your bio and artist statement will be included in our "Artists Book", displayed in the Gallery.

SELL YOUR WORK IN OUR BOUTIQUE

SMALL 2D and 3D ORIGINAL WORK, PRINTS, JEWELRY, CARDS AND GIFT ITEMS

Space is available in our Artist's Eye Gallery's Boutique for members to display and sell their prints. This is great opportunity with only a small percentage of the sale price of each item sold retained by the Gallery. Boutique guidelines must be followed.

Check with the Gallery for current show fees/percentages. Members will be notified in advance of any changes.

SHOW YOUR WORK IN OTHER VENUES AND AT SPECIAL EVENTS

The Lake Worth Art League strives to share our Member Artists' fine art with the community. As a member, from time to time, you will have the opportunity to exhibit original work under the LWAL banner within venues throughout the area. Depending on the venue, art requirements and fees will vary. Membership includes the cost of liability insurance for all of our outdoor shows.

MORE BENEFITS...

Member meetings and social events are held to bring you together with members, fellow artists, and patrons. A monthly online newsletter keeps you abreast of show results, happenings, our member's achievements, and special events. Members receive special pricing on classes and workshops. Every member is entitled to cast a vote electing the Board of Directors, and whenever a special vote is called for.

MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES

The LWAL is run by member volunteers. We encourage all to volunteer. Members who have items in the Gallery or in the Boutique are required to work a 4 hour shift in the Gallery one time each month that the items appear. Shift duties consist of opening, manning, and closing the gallery, answering the phone, and handling sales transactions. Training is provided. Members who choose not to exhibit, or do so infrequently, must work a minimum of 4 shifts each calendar year (pro-rated for new members). Those who wish to waive sitting a shift may elect to pay the LWAL to hire someone to sit for them. Student Members are exempt from sitting. Members who do not fulfill their required hours will be billed and participation in exhibitions and boutique will be suspended until the hours are made up or the bill is paid.
