If you're interested in applying for Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding in the FY2023 cycle, then you must complete a one-page Notice of Intent form per project and submit an electronic copy (Word or PDF) to Housing First Solano CoC Staff at admin@capsolanojpa.org no later than **3 pm on August 30, 2023**. Please submit the form even if you are only considering applying, as **agencies who do not submit a form will not be eligible to apply**. Minor changes in your program design will be permitted after submission.

All projects **must** match any funds requested on a 1:1 basis. For example, if you request \$40,000 in funding, you must match it with \$40,000 in funding or in kind from a non-ESG source, for a total budget of \$80,000. Applicants interested in applying for the match exemption must submit the request and required documentation at the time of their application via eCivis. HCD will allocate the \$100,000 exemption, at their discretion, to no more than two Subrecipients who receive the highest 'match exemption score.' HCD has the final decision on which Subrecipient(s) benefit from the match exemption and its decision cannot be appealed.
