We would like to thank you for your support in the year 2020. It was a year of unprecedented change and hardship for families, businesses, and communities. We have witnessed firsthand the devastation COVID-19 has caused our patients and their families. It is now, more than ever, that support from our community continues. Due to the changes in the last year, it is important that we can assure you and your loved ones that we are providing you with the best care possible.

WHAT IS A MEMBERSHIP?

Every year our company sends out mailers for a subscription to our Ambulance Service. An Ambulance subscription is a wise investment that could save you hundreds of dollars. Like Doctor offices, with most insurances, Ambulance care has a co-pay. With a subscription to our Ambulance Membership, our company will waive your co-pay fees for an Emergency Trip and for Refusal of Transport. There are different options which include: Single, Family (those that live in the same residence as yourself), and Senior rates. This subscription unfortunately does not cover non-emergency transports, for example: Hospital-to-Nursing Home or Hospital-to-Hospital copays/deductibles.

UPDATES AT RHL AMBULANCE CO.

We are happy to share that over the previous year we have obtained 4 new Ventilator/CPAP machines, one for each ambulance and our Command vehicle. These allow us to ventilate a patient on-scene through a machine so that we are accurately able to control their breathing. During the pandemic, having these capabilities has been more important than ever. We have also received 4 brand new Cardiac Monitors. Not only is this device able to obtain a 12-Lead EKG in the field, but has CPR feedback to increase the accuracy of CPR, and also has Carbon Monoxide monitoring built-in. Having this new equipment is a great asset to help ensure your loved ones are getting the best possible care in their time of need.

As some of you may have noticed, we have been maintaining our best efforts to use protective gear when treating patients. This has included P100 respirators, N-95 masks, Surgical gowns and masks, goggles, and gloves. It is our highest priority to take the highest precautions in order to keep our staff, our patients, and their families healthy and safe.


