



- H.R. 6655 would direct states to review the designations of local areas in the state and propose redesignations of local areas.
- Would establish a new demonstration authority allowing four eligible states (and six approved local areas within a state) to apply to consolidate funding with broad flexibility.
- Would permit states to reserve an additional 10 percent (on top of the 15 percent Governor's reserve) to support employer-led training.



- Would require that at least 50% of the adult and dislocated worker funding allocated to local areas support eligible training activities.
- Would reform eligible training provider list requirements and adjust the performance accountability system.
- Would provide states and local areas more flexibility to serve in-school youth.



- Workforce Pell for training 8 - 15 weeks
- Biden re-writing of apprenticeship rules makes less flexible
- Requirement to use Wagner merit staff remains
