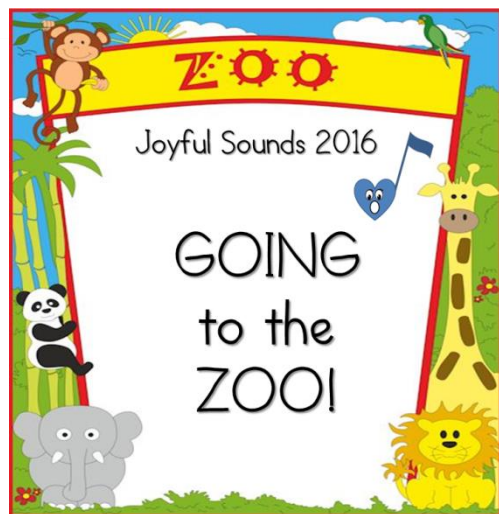

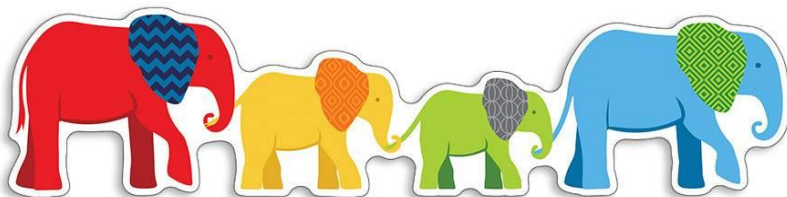

### One Elephant

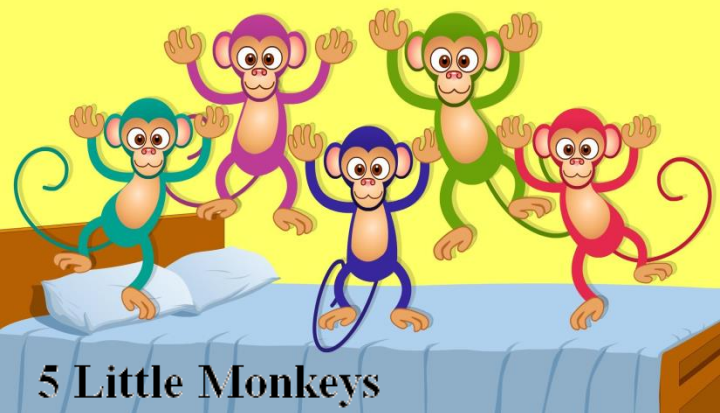
One el - e - phant went out to play,

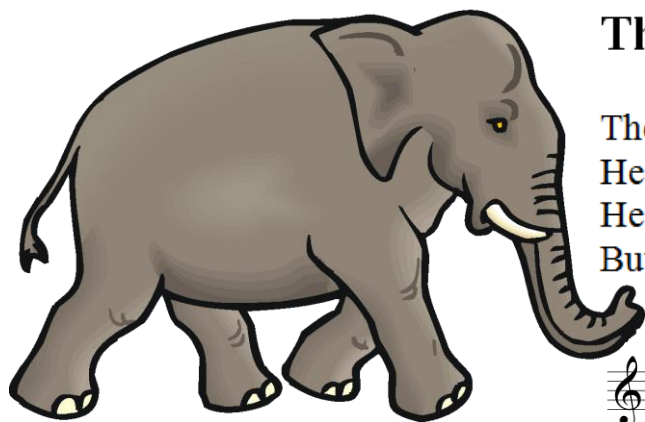

But goodness gracious, what a nose!

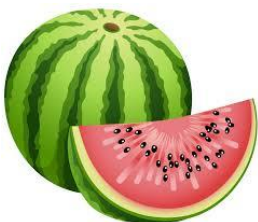

My mother will say

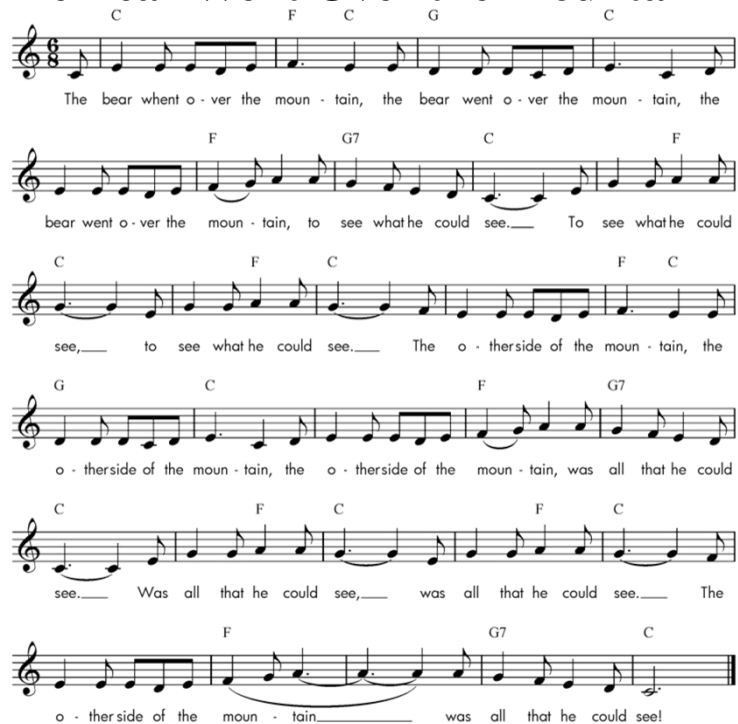
