# Chapter 12

# **Trouble With The Elders**

**BIBLE** 

Then rose up certain of the elders of the land, and spoke to all the assembly of the people, saying: "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly are ravening wolves.<sup>2</sup>

"It is better to hear the rebuke of the wise, than for a man to hear the song of fools.<sup>3</sup>

"Thus says the Lord Yahweh, Woe to the foolish prophets, who follow their own spirit, and have seen nothing!<sup>4</sup> Behold, these are the wicked. Being always at ease, they increase in riches.<sup>5</sup>

"For such men are false apostles, deceitful workers, masquerading as Christ's apostles. The harp, lyre, tambourine, and flute, with wine, are at their feasts; but they don't respect the work of Yahweh, neither have they considered the operation of his hands.

  - Isaiah 5:12 The Sixties was a decade of great social change. The innovative music that the Beatles and their peers created helped to inspire a spirit of rebellion from young people. Musicians became spokespersons for a whole new way of thinking. "We were all on this ship- a ship going to discover the New World, and the Beatles were in the crow's nest," John recalled. Not everyone was on board however. Many of the "elders," including parents, teachers, government leaders, and religious authorities, condemned what they saw as excess and felt that society was headed in the wrong direction. They urged a return to more traditional values.

"Though they say, 'As Yahweh lives;' surely they swear falsely.<sup>8</sup> Many will follow their immoral ways, and as a result, the way of the truth will be maligned.<sup>9</sup>

"It will happen in that day, that the prophets will each be ashamed of his vision, when he prophesies; neither will they wear a hairy mantle to deceive.<sup>10</sup>

"Now therefore, behold, Yahweh has put a lying spirit in the mouth of these your prophets; and Yahweh has spoken evil concerning you.<sup>11</sup>

"To what then will I liken the people of this generation? What are they like?<sup>12</sup> They are all grievous rebels, going about with slanders; they are brass and iron: they all of them deal corruptly.<sup>13</sup>

"There is a generation that curses their father, and doesn't bless their mother.<sup>14</sup> For it is a rebellious people, lying children, children who will not hear the law of Yahweh. <sup>15</sup>

"There is a generation that is pure in their own eyes, yet are not washed from their filthiness. <sup>16</sup> These are wells without water, clouds driven by a storm; for whom the blackness of darkness has been reserved forever. <sup>17</sup>

### COMMENTARY

"These have one mind, and they give their power and authority to the beast.<sup>18</sup> If a man walking in a spirit of falsehood lies: 'I will prophesy to you

falsehood lies: 'I will prophesy to you of wine and of strong drink'; he would be the prophet of this people.<sup>19</sup>

"These are they who cause divisions, and are sensual, not having the Spirit,<sup>20</sup> whose end is destruction, whose god is the belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who think about earthly things.<sup>21</sup>

"For some of these are people who creep into houses, and take captive gullible women loaded down with sins, led away by various lusts.<sup>22</sup> For they eat the bread of wickedness, and drink the wine of violence.<sup>23</sup>

"Their wine is the poison of serpents, The cruel venom of asps.<sup>24</sup> The wild donkeys stand on the bare heights, they pant for air like jackals; their eyes fail, because there is no herbage.<sup>25</sup>

"Yet in the same way, these also in their dreaming defile the flesh, despise authority, and slander celestial beings,<sup>26</sup> being filled with all unrighteousness, sexual immorality, wickedness, covetousness, malice; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, evil habits; secret slanderers,<sup>27</sup> backbiters, hateful to God, insolent, haughty, boastful, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents.<sup>28</sup>

"There is a generation, oh how lofty are their eyes! Their eyelids are lifted up.<sup>29</sup>

"When they tell you, 'Consult with those who have familiar spirits and with the wizards, who chirp and who mutter,' shouldn't a people consult with their God? Should they consult the dead on behalf of the living?<sup>30</sup>

"Cut off your hair, [Jerusalem], and cast it away, and take up a lamentation on the bare heights; for Yahweh has rejected and forsaken the generation of his wrath.<sup>31</sup>

"Wake up, you drunkards, and weep! Wail, all you drinkers of wine, because of the sweet wine; for it is cut off from your mouth.<sup>32</sup>

"Because you have burned incense, and because you have sinned against Yahweh, and have not obeyed the voice of Yahweh, nor walked in his law, nor in his statutes, nor in his testimonies; therefore this evil has happened to you, as it is this day.<sup>33</sup>

"Isn't your wickedness great? Neither is there any end to your iniquities?",34

The apostles and the elders were gathered together to see about this matter.<sup>35</sup>
