

## BALL BUSTER RALLY

Date of Rally: Saturday, March 9, 2019

Start Time: 9:00 am. Staggered starts at five-minute intervals. The Start Check will be closed after the last car leaves the parking lot.

Location: Walmart parking lot on the West side of Sanderson Ave across from Farmer Boy's. Look for black 2004 Corvette.

Check Points: This is Check Point #1. There will be a total of five check points. The Start, three Field Checks and the Finish Check. You must turn in your Instruction Sheets from each Check Point to be considered a Finisher.

Handouts: At each check, a sheet of directions and special instructions will be given to either the driver or navigator. The names of both the driver and navigator must be listed on the sign-up sheet. The Special Instructions/Directions will be handed out by either a Checker (Club Member) or will be contained in a coffee can that you must locate at a designated site. The cans will be marked #1, #2 or #3, corresponding to the number that you are assigned at Sign-Up. You will keep this number through the entire Rally. NO EXCEPTIONS. You must answer any and all questions that are on the instruction sheet. You will be disqualified if they are left blank.

ADDED CHALLENGES: You may be required to draw a card from a basket and/or seek a coffee can with your next Instruction Sheet and/or a specific task that only you must complete. No task is impossible to complete but must have your individual attention and concentration of your navigator. You may also be directed to drive in a different direction from other entrants, so don't always follow the car in front of you.

AWARDS: Finisher Pins will be given to only those that complete the course and turn in their Instruction Sheets. If you miss a Check or get lost, you are out of luck.

FEE: \$10.00 per person. An additional \$10.00 is required if the navigator also wishes to have a pin. These are rare mementos for the sweat and sacrifice you endured. If you do not finish your entry fee will be donated to the club.

COURSE REVIEW: Only the brave should sign-up. You must be able read English, follow directions, have an even temper and have a strong relationship with your navigator. I cannot promise that separations won't occur. Are you a wimp? Are you afraid of spiders and snakes? Do you still play with Legos? This is a fun, but demanding course.
