- ✓ is NOT late arriving at school

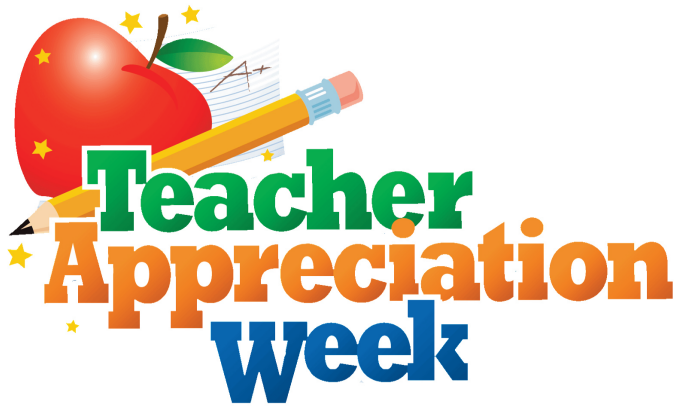
