INNER HEALING SEMINAR PART 2

This Inner Healing Seminar comprises 2 parts – Part 1 took place on 8 November and Part 2 on 15 November 2017. Praise and worship of the greatness of God preceded this seminar which started at 8pm. 170 people registered for Part 2. As in Part 1, the speaker was Deacon Clement Samuel, Head of the Healing & Deliverance Ministry of Penang Diocese.

Deacon Clement spoke on the subject of healing and the 10 Commandments, how spiritual healing can be obtained through the Sacrament of Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick.

[CCC 1532](#) states **The special grace of the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick has as its effects:**

**1. The uniting of the sick person to the passion of Christ, for his own good and that of the whole Church;**

**2. The strengthening, peace, and courage to endure in a Christian manner.**

**3. The forgiveness of sins.**

**4. The restoration of health, if it is conducive to the salvation of his soul;**

**5. The preparation for passing over to eternal life.**

He also outlined some of the misconceptions of the healing ministry e.g., 1) All sickness is caused by sin and 2) Sin generates sickness. He led the audience to reflect on Job where sickness can be a test; [John 9:2-3](#) where sickness can be for the glory of God; [Colossians 1:24](#) where suffering can be redemptive and in [Luke 13:4-5](#) where trials are an invitation to repentance. Deacon went on to explain how sins cause hindrances in receiving healing and blessings from God; examples of "modern day" sins against the 10 commandments.

He led participants to repentance prayer before the exposed Blessed Sacrament claiming the cleansing, deliverance and healing power of the Precious Blood of Jesus. A piece of red cloth covering the head of the one prayed over symbolized the covering of the Blood of Jesus.

The evening and seminar closed with a fellowship of hot coffee and finger food on a rainy night with grateful hearts to God for many healings took place, testament of the glowing and radiant faces of participants.
