We got a huge assist from the Patriots Foundation (coats leftover from a veterans event in Merrimack) and support from the Merrimack community with goods delivered to our collection box in the library foyer. The bulk of items came from our members either as newly purchased items, 'like new' items, or monetary donations used for additional purchases. The veterans were thrilled as were our contacts at the Manchester VA. When finished, members of different VA departments (social workers for the homeless, support for veterans going through chemotherapy, psychology services) claimed whatever was left so that they could offer it to veterans who did not attend the distribution event. Tammy and I had fun helping the vets try on coats, find hats/gloves, and encouraging them to not forget to take socks.
