EXHIBITS

FLOOR EXHIBITS:

Front viewing - Most exhibits will be against a perimeter wall that has been draped to 8' high with green cloth. Exhibits will be 8', 10' or 12' wide and they will be separated by "wings" of the same green drape. The exhibit depth (back to front) should be a minimum of 3' and a maximum of 6'. They will, therefore, measure from 24 to 72 square feet.

Free-standing - There is an option for a limited number of free-standing exhibits which measure approximately 100 sq. ft. Visitors will be able to view these exhibits from all sides.

Most any material will suffice as a base ... sod, bark, wood chips, moss, gravel, pavers etc. are appropriate. **Water features are encouraged**. Although the room is evenly lit from above, bring small spotlights if you wish to create dramatic effects or highlight feature plants. In general, exhibit height should be kept to 8'. However, plants or props in the rear of an exhibit may extend to 10' high.

WARDIAN CASES: By invitation as in previous years.

TABLETOPS: Limited number available by special request and with pre-approval only reserved primarily for vendors who will be flying into Philadelphia. Plant placement area will measure approximately 15 square feet.
