**\*\* Freestyle Rule**"Except for USEF/USDF Championship classes and for FEI Pony Riders, FEI Junior, FEI Young Rider and FEI Para-Equestrian Freestyles, in order to enter a freestyle class at any level, a horse/rider combination must have received a minimum score of 63% in the highest test of the declared freestyle level or any test of a higher level at a Federation Licensed or FEI recognized Dressage Competition or "open" Dressage class (i.e. open to all breeds) at a Federation Licensed Competition held prior to the competition where the horse/rider combination is entered to ride a freestyle class. A photocopy of the test verifying eligibility, or copy of the USDF score verification, must be submitted with the entry for a freestyle class

20 x 60m in outdoor ring has fiber footing. Please lunge horses in designated area only.

6. **DIRECTIONS**— Canterbury address is 23100 W Newberry Rd., Newberry, FL 32669. From I-75 take exit 387 (Newberry Rd)  
And go west ~10 miles. Canterbury Showplace is on your right hand side.

7. **FOOD**— food concession on grounds.

8. **VETERINARIAN AND FARRIER**- names and numbers will posted on show grounds in office, stabling info board and in show program.

9. **REFUNDS**— Full refund less office fee before closing date. After closing date office stall fees & association fees, will be refunded if horse is withdrawn on a vet cert. or rider with a medical certificate before 1st day of the show. Class fees not refundable.

10. **SHARPS DISPOSAL:** — Competition management may fine any individuals including owners, exhibitors, trainers, or their agent up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. Sharps disposals are available in the barn area.

11. **Miscellaneous Rules:** Dogs must be contained or leashed at all times. No lunging in designated warm up areas.  
No parking allowed between barns. No smoking permitted in barn area.

12. **IMPORTANT:** All entries shall be on the official entry form of the show. The entry form should be completed in every detail; otherwise, the record of wins may not be properly credited. The show management reserves the right to return any incomplete entry form. All entries must be accompanied by a complete payment. A fee of \$50.00 will be added to any account due if any person gives a non-negotiable check. Non-negotiable checks will be turned over to USEF per Rule XV, Article 1508 .

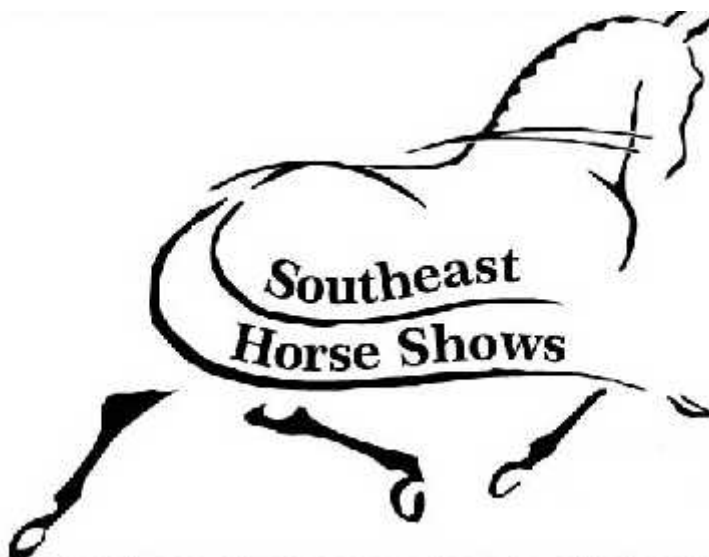

*Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardians), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include the exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.*



## 2019 Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot except Friesian Performance FR 222 and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
