Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips or cracks. A few minor scratches, dings and nicks here and there. The limbs had a number of superficial stress marks (no cracks), scratches and considerable "yellowing". I refinished the limbs but saved the original decals, which are only in fair condition and show the previously "yellowing" of the old varnish. There is also a 3" superficial stress line in the lower part of the decorative overlay, just above the limb (see pic p. 3)
