Our club tries to have a Hunt twice a year for members only (Spring and Fall) for coins and prizes.

At the side of the room is the membership desk. Be sure to sign in at each meeting, as you are eligible for the membership drawing. To be eligible to win you must be present at the meeting and signed the book. The prize is \$5.00 and if not claimed will be added to the prize of the next monthly drawing.
