MESSAGE FROM YOUR EDITOR






FIVE O'CLOCK CRUISE 3 FEBRUARY 29, 2020

TRISHA'S MAKE AHEAD BREAKFAST CASSEROLE

This was always a request from our overnight guests at our 4th of July parties.

Make ahead and just pop in the oven the day after the fireworks!

Ingredients:

12 oz. bacon, cut into pieces

2 1/2 C. Tater Tots, thawed

8 oz. fresh portabella mushrooms, sliced

1 small onion, chopped

12 eggs

1/3 C. sour cream

8 oz. shredded cheddar cheese

6 slices Swiss cheese

Instructions:

Cook bacon in skillet, stirring occasionally, until crisp. Remove and drain on a paper towel. Reserve 2 T. of drippings in skillet and add mushrooms and onions. Cook until onions are tender and crisp, stirring occasionally. Add Tater Tots to a greased 13" x 9" casserole dish, pressing on the bottom and along the sides to make a crust. Whisk eggs and sour cream until well blended. Add mushrooms and onions and pour into crust. Top with bacon and cheeses. NOTE:

If refrigerating overnight, cover and wait to add bacon and cheeses until cooking.

Bake at 350 for 40 minutes, or until center is set and cheese is browned. Let sit 5 minutes before serving with salsa, herb butter, and toasted crusty bread.



HOMEMADE BOOZY LEMONADE SLUSHIE

Similar to Lemon Drop shots, these will add an extra kick to fireworks watching!

Ingredients:

2 C. sugar

2 C. water

8 oz. Smirnoff Red, White & Berry

Vodka

12 whole lemons

4 C. additional water

Crushed ice

Sugar for rim of glasses

Lemon slices for garnish

Instructions:

Heat the sugar and water in a medium saucepan until dissolved. Juice the

lemons. Pour lemon juice in a pitcher and add in 3/4ths of the simple syrup, vodka and ice. Pour in 4 cups of water. Stir. Adjust taste by adding in more water, simple syrup, or vodka. Store in the freezer until ready to serve. Dip wet glass rim in sugar, add slushie and lemon slice.



A dear friend always made this yummy dessert for our 4th of July parties

Ingredients:

Crust:

1 1/2 C. finely crushed graham cracker crumbs

1/4 C. white sugar

6 T. butter, melted

Filling:

2 C. cream cheese at room

temperature

2 t. grated lemon zest

2 t. lemon juice

1 t. vanilla extract

1/3 C. white sugar

1 1/4 C. whipped cream

20 large fresh strawberries, hulled and halved lengthwise, or as needed

24 large fresh blueberries, or as needed

Instructions:

Combine graham cracker crumbs, 1/4 cup sugar, and melted butter in a bowl until mixture is thoroughly combined and crumbly.

Transfer crust mixture to a 9x11-inch baking dish. Press crust into bottom of dish until smooth and even. Cover dish with plastic wrap and refrigerate until set, about 30 minutes.

Put softened cream cheese in a bowl. Stir in lemon zest, lemon juice, and vanilla extract. Mix until combined.

Whisk 1/3 cup sugar into whipping cream in a separate metal or glass bowl. Add to the cream cheese mixture and gently whisk until filling is combined.

Spoon filling into the graham cracker crust, spreading and smoothing the top. Tap the pan gently on a work surface several times to settle the crust and filling. Cover pan tightly with plastic wrap and refrigerate until chilled and set, at least 3 hours. Arrange strawberry halves in a horizontal line to make the stripes,

leaving space in the upper left corner for the blueberries. Cut cake into squares to serve.
