We will discuss leveling up as a reloader and getting to that next level in reloading skill.

Our newbie may own one piece of equipment with which to perform one reloading function, one press, one powder measure, and one scale. He has not yet progressed into "production mode." He loads enough to shoot, to have some fun, to hunt with.

Progressing to the mid-level reloading rung, I purchased a Lee turret press, a case trimmer, a couple of calipers, a chronograph, and other assorted accessories. I was now able to produce one loaded cartridge without having to take the case out of the shell holder. I also bought a Hornady digital scale, the small portable one that doesn't take up room on your bench. I was quite happy with this setup, but I kept adding to my gun inventory, and pretty soon, I was loading for more calibers than you could shake a stick at.

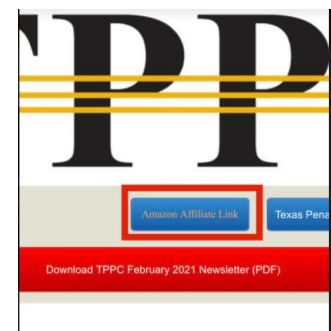

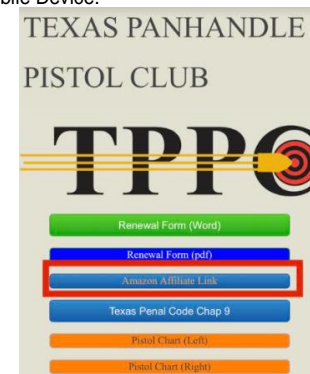

An unknown man allegedly walked into an unlocked home in Statesville, N.C., while the homeowner and his 7-year-old son were making dinner. The man reportedly claimed he was owed money, but the homeowner told him he had no idea what he was talking about and told the stranger to leave "dozens of times." A Capitol Hill lawmaker installed via a multi-million dollar push from Bloomberg gun control groups delivered this week one of the most sweeping gun bans proposed in U.S. history.

U.S. Rep. Lucy McBath (D-Ga.) on Monday announced the House version of the controversial new Gas-Operated Semi-Automatic Firearms Exclusion, or GOSAFE, Act. While past "assault weapon bans" use a combination of naming specific models – such as AR-15s – and their cosmetic features to target semi-automatic firearms, the GOSAFE Act targets pistols, rifles, and shotguns that use any sort of spent propellant gases to cycle the action during the reload process.
