Costume Care

- Dance costumes should not be worn to play in prior to the show date. Be sure to store your costume(s) out of reach from small children and pets!
- Do not iron costumes! If wrinkled, you can steam them or hang them in the bathroom while running a hot shower to release wrinkles. Tutu costumes should be hung upside down.
- Do not eat or drink while wearing recital costumes.
- Remember these costumes are NOT custom made, your child may need slight alterations which should be manageable by either a family member or local tailor.
- Tights should be worn only on rehearsal and show date. We will sell back-ups at the theater in case of an emergency. Cost is \$10/pair.



Hair & Make-Up

Future, Twinkle, and Sparkle Star female students will all wear their hair sides up with curls. Hair bows should be securely fastened with bobby pins centered on top of the head.

Shooting Stars and all students in 7+ classes will wear their hair in a slicked back low bun, with a middle part. Hair bows should be securely fastened with bobby pins centered over the bun.

We ask that all female dancers wear a minimum of blush, brown/tan eyeshadow, red lipstick, and mascara.

Male dancers please style hair neatly with product.
