

We welcomed visiting Lion Warren Heathman, PDG, Downtown Portland, Oregon Lions.

Our guest speaker was Greg Purdy, Public Affairs Manager at the Palm Springs Aerial Tramway. He informed us of the history of the tram. The board of directors is primarily interested in improving and maintaining the facilities.

They have recently installed new water tanks and a \$700 million dollar parking system. They've also upgraded all utilities.

Another project in the works is the establishment of a Tramway Museum. They will welcome donations of any artifacts related to the tram.

Last year the tram had over 600,000 riders, a new record. Over twenty million visitors have used the tram since its opening.
