James “Danny” Faucett joined the Longhorn Organics team after 22 years in the offshore oil and gas industry, working in the Gulf of Mexico and internationally. Danny earned an Associate of Applied Science degree in Automotive Technology from Texas State Technical College, Waco in 1989 and worked as an automotive technician before enlisting in the US Navy. While in the navy, he reached the rank of Machinist Mate 2nd class petty officer (MM2 or E-5) stationed on the aircraft carrier USS Independence (CV-62) which was home ported in Yokosuka Japan and rose to the position of assistant work center supervisor, damage control petty officer, and machinist mate of the watch. He was qualified to operate, maintain, and emergency/casualty operate the equipment in his work center. Equipment included ship’s service turbine generators (generating 1,500 kw each), low pressure flash type distilling plants (water makers capable of producing 240,000gpd), and high pressure (3,000psi 30cfh) and low pressure (125psi, 1250cfm) air compressors and all associated pumps and ancillary equipment.

After his enlistment in the navy, Danny transitioned to civilian life by joining a training program with an oilfield service company, where he was trained in subsea drilling and production equipment and worked extensively in the Gulf of Mexico. That opportunity allowed Danny to branch out into consulting for national and multi-national oil companies with assignments in the Gulf of Mexico, Corpus Christi, Ingleside, Mexico, Argentina, Chile, Norway, France, Bahamas, Angola, Namibia, and South Africa. Just prior to joining Longhorn Organics, Danny was the subsea execution supervisor for Esso Exploration Angola Ltd. (EEAL) Angola, West Africa, where he was sole company representative on an offshore construction vessel and managed day to day operation of the vessel and service companies operating on the vessel, with contracts under his direct supervision totaling \$1.8 million USD per month. Responsibilities included the safe operation of the vessel, extensive equipment assets and the 54 personnel working on the vessel.

Since joining our team, Danny has used his prior experience managing complex project operations and his hands on skills operating and maintaining heavy equipment and pumps and associated hardware to support and assist bringing several key projects to a successful completion.
