RE-FINANCE:

Ancient Wisdom for Modern Money Management Money, Money, Money

Money can be a helpful tool and a valuable resource, but it makes for a lousy boss. Ask people their opinion about money, and you'll be left with a variety of answers: they love it, hate it, spend it, save it, want it, work for it, beg for it, borrow it, steal it, invest it, and give it.
