



STRAY ANIMALS

As a general rule, no-kill shelters and rescues are not legally able to accept lost, stray or abandoned animals from the public.

The majority of our animals come to us from animal control services. These organizations are responsible for stray animal pick-ups, cruelty cases, and enforcing licensing laws. Your local animal control agency is the only entity that is contracted to offer animal control services to your city or county.

Please keep in mind that surrendering a stray animal over to animal control means you are giving the animal the best chance of be reunited with its family.
