The overall average for the heifers was in the \$.80/lb. range for the nicer groups of all sizes. The steers were in the same range, maybe just a touch higher. The calf market was steady to just a little weaker. Springers and Dairy Cows were steady with the last couple weeks, but slightly weaker than a month ago. Butcher cows were off a couple cents following last week's rally. Butcher steers were steady after last week's drop off. Organic Butcher cows were higher again, with several cows bringing over \$1.00/lb. Wow! I keep wishing, like I'm sure you all are, for drier weather. We just can't seem to catch a break. I'm sure it won't take long to get alot of planting done as soon as we get the opportunity, but it's also June 1<sup>st</sup>. Only time will tell what effects this will have on yields and prices.
