## FRANKSTON

Characterised by its coastal location and award winning beaches, Frankston City is one of Australia's best kept secrets that offers visitors and residents the best of both worlds: a sea change, with all the mod cons a city has to offer. With a number of high rise buildings, stunning rooftop views and a plethora of laneways, Frankston's city centre precinct could be called a microcosm of Melbourne CBD. Some of the largest walls in the City Centre have recently been transformed into street art from international artist, which has been enabled from The Big Picture Fest. ## Pre-event Registration

It is compulsory for all athletes/teams to check in for their respective sports, no later than 30 minutes before play is scheduled to start. Please see the Event Schedule for Sport Starting times. The registration tent will be located next to the 13CABS water play area.

**TEAMS** only require one member to check-in; however, they must ensure that all team member information is correct and up-to-date at check-in. The team representative must complete the provided **Team Member Registration Form** and hand that in at Check in.

**COMPETITOR ID WRISTBAND (SWIM and AQUATHLON ONLY)** Must be worn at all times after receiving at check in and will allow you access to competitor only areas.

## Pre-Event Briefings

It is compulsory for all competitors to attend the Pre-Race Briefing 15mins prior to event start, applicable to their event. Briefings will occur at the field of play just prior to the start of competition.

## Bag Compound

A bag compound will be available to all competitors near the registration/information tent. Athletes must clearly mark their own bag with identification. **Please DO NOT leave any valuables in the bag compound.**

## Medical Information & Insurance

We recommend that you take out your own personal medical insurance for competing and all competitors should have ambulance cover. If you do have an accident you must pay for your own medical expenses therefore it is essential for you to obtain adequate personal medical insurance/cover.

**FIRST AID / MEDICAL** will be located in the event precinct and roving around various areas. If you require first aid assistance, please notify a staff person, marshal or official who will be able to phone for assistance.

## Competitor Safety

It is the responsibility of competitors to ensure that they are sufficiently skilled in all aspects of the event they are competing in and have attained an appropriate level of fitness to be able to compete confidently. Competitors must be in good health and not suffering from any illness that may cause difficulties during the event. Competitors must also ensure that they understand and abide by all applicable rules to their event and exercise due caution where necessary.

## Lost Property

Any personal items that are lost or misplaced, and handed in to event officials will be available for collection at the Information tent on the day or email [info@eventpeople.com.au](mailto:info@eventpeople.com.au) post event with details of your lost property. If lost property is not able to be picked up from Event People, cost to post the property will be at the competitor's expense. The race organiser does not take responsibility for lost property.

# CONTINGENCY PLANS

A Contingency Committee has been established to consult, make decisions and manage the implementation of any contingency plan.

Event People reserves the right to alter the event, start time and/or event format without notice because of circumstances outside the control of the organiser and under the direction of sponsors, councils, police or other organisations that are associated with the event.

The Contingency Committee will make their decision should conditions such as, but not limited to, any of the following be either forecast or prevail:

- Extreme temperature
- Extreme weather conditions

The Contingency Committee may consider implementing one or more of the following strategies if deemed necessary in the interests of athlete safety:

- Shorten the event duration
- Start the event earlier or later
- Cancel the event.

If the Committee's decision at any time is to change the advertised event format, this will be advised to athletes on the day the decision is made, and subsequent days leading into the event.
