


Reverend Vincent Mahon: Born 1/5/1896 - Died July 10, 1984 Fr. Mahon was ordained July 18, 1920 and was the Pastor of St Joseph's from 1943-1946. At that time, St. Patrick's was a mission church of St Joseph's. When St Patrick's became its own parish, Fr. Mahon became the pastor, first in the original church on James Street, and continued as pastor after building the new church on the corner of High Street and 4th.


