

# School Age Children



We have a fun time at Rosebud's Child Care! Before school, we can eat breakfast. Breakfast for school age children starts at 7:30 am and is served until 8 am. This usually gives them enough time to eat before the arrival of the bus at 8:20 am. The bus stop is located right at the

end of the driveway, so on rainy days or really cold days, we can wait inside until the bus comes! On days when there is a delay or no school, breakfast is served until 9 am.

There are lots of activities for the older children such as learning games, board games, arts and crafts, puzzles, building toys, books, play dough, and so much more! Outside, there are bubbles, hula hoops, chalk and many assorted ball games to play. If your child attends in the summer, Rosebud's has a New York State approved pool plan which allows her to take all the children swimming. Both Rose and her assistant are infant/child/adult CPR Certified. During the school year, children are able to work on homework, with help as needed.

The New York State license for Rosebud's Child Care allows there to be no more than 16 children. Of these children, 4 can be under the age of 2 and 4 can be school age. No immunization records are needed for school age children because the school is responsible for this.
