Hillary attended the Rapson School and graduated from Harbor Beach High School in 1966. He married his high school sweetheart, Delphine Ulfig, on August 5, 1967. They raised five children whom he was very proud of and loved very much. His eleven grandchildren were his pride and joy. Hillary worked at Pontiac Motors before joining the United States Marine Corps in 1967. After serving two years, he returned home to work on the family farm and began a 37 year career at the Port Hope Road Commission first as a truck driver, and later as a foreman. He was a member of the American Legion Post 197 of Harbor Beach and the Rat Patrol #3341. After his retirement, he enjoyed spending time at his cabin, the "Varmint Den", hunting with his children and grandchildren, and hosting his annual deer camp.
