Supported Decision Making is a less restrictive and less costly alternative to guardianship. Supported decision making allows individuals to make their own decisions and stay in charge of their lives while receiving the help and assistance they need to do so. Using a supported-decision making agreement, a person with a disability chooses someone they trust to serve as their supporter.
