- 1 roll of clear contact paper to cover workbooks (purchase now or during the summer)
- (1) 12 inch ruler
- 1 pocket dictionary and thesaurus

Summer Reading Cinema

Many great books have been made into films. For this project students will assume the role of a movie producer. Students will showcase their thought, effort and especially, creativity as they complete this activity.

This assignment has **4 parts**: students will draw up a map that captures the book's setting, create a flow chart that describes the sequence of events from the book, write a character description for each of the main characters and which actor/actress they want to play each role, and draw up a billboard that entices people to see the movie.

Students will turn in all 4 parts of the assignment by the first day of school. Each page of the assignment should be staples or paper-clipped together and each page must have the student's name.

Map

On 8.5" x 11" blank paper students are to draw a map of the story's setting as they see it. At least 10 places in the story must be labeled on the map. It should include color.

Flow Chart

On 8.5" x 11" blank paper students are to draw a flow chart that describes the main events of the book. The chart must have at least 10 boxes.

Character Description

Students are to write a character description for each of the book's main characters. It should include the appearance of the character, the approximate age, and what part the character plays in the story. Students should assign an actor or actress for each of the characters they describe.

Billboard

On 8.5" x 11" blank paper students are to draw a Billboard that makes people want to see the movie. Every billboard must have a catchphrase and should include color.

Incoming 5th Grade students are required to read **one** of the books from the list below and complete the assignment on the following page. The due date for the assignment will be the first day of school.
