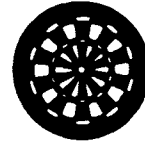

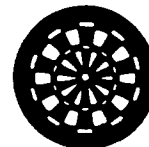

Congratulations to Mark Grencoavage who won re-election as the DDA's President. Mark well deserved the honor to serve as Executive Officer of our association in that he faced an uphill battle the entire 1988-89 season.

For the unaware, Mark handily won the Vice President's seat during the elections of 1988. Mark had attended several Board meetings before the elections and decided to become more involved in the daily operations of the league.

With some discussions as to the then President's possible resignation, Mark felt it would be difficult to take the reigns of the DDA as he was new to the operations of the Board. The President decided not to resign at election time so Mark allowed his name to be tendered for nomination as Vice President.

The June 1988 Board meeting brought surprise as the President indeed resigned and in accordance with the DDA By Laws Mark immediately became President. This delayed the Board's actions to begin the 1988-89 season until the July meeting which meant all preparations such as formation of committees, membership fees, sponsorship fees, format of play, rules for league play, etc. were forced back by thirty days at least. This immediately put Mark behind the proverbial eight ball as applications and league details needed to be released by August so applications could be returned for scheduling.

One of Mark's primary concerns were the By Laws and Rules For League Play which Mark felt needed revised for language and clarity. The committee of Mark, Pete Mougey, Mark Ferguson and myself spent two days a week for the entire month of August detailing the By Laws. The committee hours totaled in excess of forty hours and this did not include the individual time each of us spent between the committee meetings.

With one hell of a lot of work behind us, the league started. Then in September the Miami Valley "Killer Flu" struck several Board members. This violent strain of flu took its toll as some families passed the bug back and forth throughout the winter. This interfered with the DDA in that several so afflicted Board members just couldn't stay well long enough to put the needed hours into their projects.

As the flu wore on the next surprise was that two Board members were hospitalized and out of commission for several weeks.

With the surprise of becoming President at his first Board meeting, the delay and hassle of setting up the dart season, illness affecting certain key Board members, two Board members hospitalized, a delayed newsletter, Mark had to ask "when is it going to stop?".
