

RESULTADOS DE LAS ENCUESTAS SOBRE DE UN HORARIO NUEVO DE MISAS



Gracias a todos que participaron en nuestro proceso del discernimiento del horario nuevo por las misas del fin de semana. Ya están analizadas las encuestas; hubo 105 respuestas. Los resultados se van abajo según el numero de las preguntas principales.

#2: 80% participaron en ambas etapas de las encuestas; 20% no;

#3: **85% estuvieron en “completo acuerdo o de acuerdo” con el cambio de horario en las Misas;**

11% no; 4% no estuvieron seguros;

#5: 93% dijeron que asistan a la Misa 3-4 veces cada mes; 2% 1-2 veces por mes; 5% diez veces o menos por año; (Ojo del párroco: este figura de “93%” es muy sospechoso porque no está de acuerdo de nuestras observaciones y con cifras que ya eran publicados en nuestros boletines);

#6: 26% asistan a la Misa a las 5 PM los sábados; 39% a la Misa de 8:30; 35% a la Misa de 10:30;

#7: 57% estuvieron en favor de empezar el horario nuevo de Misas en junio; 18% en julio; 14% en el mes de agosto; 1% en septiembre; 10% “otro” (sin dar cualquier mes);

Por lo tanto, dado los resultados de las ultimas encuestas, la conclusión de nuestro proceso de discernimiento estos últimos meses es que el presupuesto horario nuevo esta aprobado. También, para dar a todos un mes para prepararse, empezará con el nuevo horario de misas el 1 de julio.





NOMINATION FORM FOR PASTORAL COUNCIL

We invite nominations from registered parishioners for the annual elections for our parish's Pastoral Council (PC). There are three vacancies to be filled this rotation. Once a list of candidates is nominated, parishioners will vote; the three candidates with the highest tallies become elected. The member of our parish's Pastoral Council coordinating this year's nomination process in conjunction with the pastor is Carolyn Campbell. As listed in our parish bulletins for the past two years and also recently, persons eligible for nomination, including self-nomination, need meet the requirements specified below. When submitting a person's name for nomination, be sure to first ask him/her if they would consent to serve. Once nominated, Carolyn will present the list of nominees to the pastor for review and after that she will contact qualified nominees. The nomination process began after Masses on May 14th, continued on May 21st, and ends after Masses this Sunday (28th) at 1 PM. Voting on the final list of candidates occurs the next two weekends, June 4th and 11th. To observe the usual voting proprieties, (e.g., a registered parishioner, voting but once, etc.) parishioner identification is needed to validate the ballot. You may either legibly print your name or write in your parish envelope number. You may nominate up to 3 candidates. Those currently serving on the Pastoral Council and thus ineligible for nomination are Lynn Ingle, Larry Banks, Miguel Yanez, Rocio Aparecio and Bernie Bosse.

REQUIREMENTS FOR A CANDIDATE TO BE NOMINATED:

- *Be in full communion with the Catholic Church and registered parishioner of St. Mary since May 14, 2016;
- *Regularly attend either the Saturday Vigil Mass or a Sunday Mass at St. Mary's most weekends of the month throughout the year (save vacations, holiday visiting, and such like). Not to attend so regularly, for whatever reason, renders one out of touch with an essential part of the parish and thus severely limited to serve in an advisory role to the pastor as a PC member;
- *Endorse our parish's mission statement and desire to serve all its ethnic groups especially its two main ones;
- *Subscribe to a "Spirituality of Stewardship" involving the sharing of their time, talent, and treasure with their parish and with our Savannah Diocese;
- * Able to attend PC's monthly meetings (Tuesday evenings) and willing to accept some committee tasks;
- *Be 18 years of age or older and conversant in English;
- *Be interested in the overall spiritual and temporal welfare of the entire parish and be without an inordinate attachment to an agenda whether one's own or that of a parish group.

Results of 2nd Wave of Parish Surveys On Proposed Mass Schedule

Our thanks again to all who participated in providing their input into the first and/or second waves of surveys on the proposed new weekend Mass schedule. The findings of the earlier wave of multi-lingual surveys and review of the discernment process was presented in previous bulletins (e.g. 4/2/17). The main results of the recent wave of surveys from 105 respondents are now presented for those who answered the questions. We are grateful to Maureen Turner for painstakingly tabulating the survey results and Pastoral Council member Lynn Ingle for reviewing the method and tabulation sheets. The findings follow except for Question #1 which just asked for one's name and Q#4 on years in parish which was previously presented.

Question #2: 80% participated in both waves of surveys; 20% did not;

Question #3: 85% strongly agreed or agreed to the proposed Mass schedule; 11% did not; 4% not sure;

Question #5: 93% say they attend Mass 3-4 times a month; 2% 1-2 times per month; 5% less than that;

(Pastor's note: 93% is way out of line with national data on Mass attendance and also our own observations)

Question #6: 26% mainly attend the 5 PM Mass; 39% the 8:30 Mass; 35% the 10:30 Mass;

Question #7: 57% favored starting the new schedule in June; 18%, July; 14%, August; 1% Sept., 10% Other.

Accordingly, the outcome of our multi-month discernment process, supported by the latest results above is that the proposed new weekend Mass schedule is approved. Further, while noting that most (57%) respondents favored starting the new schedule in June, which is next weekend, it is deemed better to give folks a full month's notice and thus the new schedule will commence the first weekend of July. In sum:

COMMENCING JULY 1ST, THE FIRST WEEKEND IN JULY, MASSES WILL NOW BE AS FOLLOWS:




