The CWGA has a STAR award program for all dogs who attained a new AKC (only) title(s) during the 2018 year.

- Eligible members must have renewed membership for the year prior to the deadline or joined the Club prior to July 1 of the year of the award.
- Eligible dogs must be owned by and reside with the member. The award will be printed with the dog's call name, the new title(s), and the year 2018 -up to 18 characters TOTAL, (which includes 4 for the year). If the dog received more than one title you can include it, but not to exceed the specified number of characters. Please list only AKC titles.

These awards will be distributed at May 30 CWGA shows /meeting. So please plan to attend and CELEBRATE your achievements. (Those not attending who request that their stars be mailed will be required to submit a postage fee prior to the mailing.)
