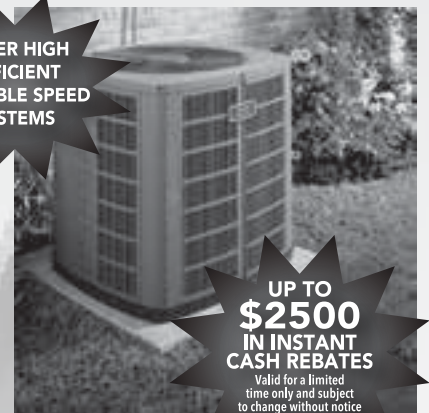

## Summary of Events

11700 block of Idlebrook Drive – Deputies were dispatched to location in reference to burglary of motor vehicle. Complainant advised that unknown suspect(s) made entry into his unlocked vehicle and stole property from inside. Follow up conducted case closed at this time due to lack of lead and/or suspect(s) or witnesses.

12800 block of Hazelway Lane – Complainant reported during the daytime hours, unknown suspects damaged his rear passenger window; however, nothing was stolen from his car. Case is currently under investigation.

12200 block of Moorcreek Drive – Deputies were dispatched to location in reference to damage to a mailbox. Case open and under investigation.

11600 block of Taos Lane – Deputies were dispatched to location in reference to Civil Writ Process. While on scene it was discovered that resident was in need of mental health services. The patient was transported to NPC for mental health evaluation. Case closed.

14200 block of Lakewood Forest Drive – Deputies responded to location in reference to a discharge of a firearm where a reportee stated they heard (3) gun shots being fired

in the area. Upon deputies diligently searching the area, they made contact on location with a male who reported he shot (3) rounds off in the ground when he observed unknown males attempting to break into his box truck. Upon speaking with other family members, their stories of the event varied. A report was completed in reference to this incident and the case is closed.

12900 block of Cluster Pine Drive – Unknown caller reported homeowners on location were in distress and that their lives were in danger. Upon deputies' arrival, they heard a screaming coming from inside the home and upon making forced entry, discovered that the call was a hoax and the homeowners became excited upon the response of deputies. A report was completed and this case is under investigation.

# Guidelines for Judging *Yard of the Month*

**Judging for April Yard of the Month to be done the last week of March in Section 10.**

Once a yard has received the "Yard of the Month" award, it is not eligible for further awards for one year. The first place winner for each month will receive a \$40 gift certificate from Plants for All Seasons and recognition in the next *Civic News*. An honorable mention yard will receive a \$25 gift certificate from Plants for All Seasons. Yards are judged in March, April, May, June, October, and November.

Judging is done by members of the garden club on a rotating basis, using the subdivision sections as listed in the Lakewood Forest Directory. It is usually done the last week of the previous month; i.e., judging for **October** would be held the last week of **September**.

Overall landscape design should be compatible with the architecture of the house; e.g., no windows hidden by shrubs, color, balanced design, etc..... 20 points

Grass: green, except in winter; mowed and edged; weed-free ..... 15 points

Beds: cleaned, edged and mulched..... 15 points

Color contrast: e.g. well placed variegated or colored shrubs, use of flowers and bulbs such as caladiums to add interest ..... 15 points

General neatness: e.g., air conditioner hidden by shrubs; garden hose rolled up, garbage cans, toys, etc. kept out of sight ..... 15 points

Shrubs: neatly pruned..... 10 points

Walks and curbs: swept and cleaned..... 10 points

100 points

# Gardening Hints From the Pro, Sherri



## April To-Do List

### In the Veggie Garden

- It's time to plant beans, cantaloupe, corn, cucumber, eggplant, honey dew, okra, peppers, summer squash, tomatillo, watermelon, basil, catmint, chives, cilantro, dill, fennel, lemongrass, mint, nasturtium, oregano, parsley, rosemary, sage, and thyme. All of these can be planted from seed, or transplants purchased from the nursery.

### In the Flowerbeds

- It's time to plant your warm weather flowers that will last all summer. The nursery is exploding with colorful options for any area of your yard.
- Make sure you prepare your beds by adding compost and fertilizer before you plant! Check out the new Color Star fertilizer; it smells like roses! Your whole yard will smell like a rose garden when you're done!

### In the Lawn

- If you haven't fertilized yet, it's OK to do it now. Do not use a Weed & Feed product unless completely necessary! If you only have a few weeds in a dormant lawn, just use a good quality lawn food like MicroLife Hybrid or NitroPhos Superturf.

- Mow on a low setting one time and bag to remove some of the thick winter thatch build-up. Make sure you adjust the height back to three inches for future mowing.
- Adjust sprinkler heads and make sure you are getting adequate coverage. Make sure sprinklers are set based on water needs. If it's been raining, then turn the sprinklers off and then back on when it dries out. Water (either too much or not enough) is the biggest problem in St. Augustine lawns. Let your lawn tell you when it's thirsty. At the first sign of wilt, give it a drink. This will promote a deeper root system, and less fungal and weed infestations.
- To save on water over the next few months, apply MicroLife Humates plus (this will help remediate the soil after last year's rains). Humates aid in water penetration and water absorption. Your lawn will thank you for it!

### Trees and Shrubs:

Do any necessary trimming and pruning if you haven't already and feed everything with a good slow release plant food like MicroLife (pink label) and apply a two-inch to three-inch layer of compost under the dripline.

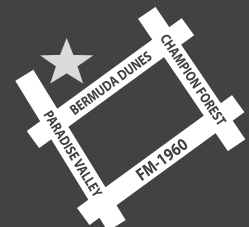
