## November 2015 Block of the Month: Spinning Star

Block finishes at 12" (unfinished at 12 1/2").
Materials:
White fabric: 8-3 1/2" squares 2-4 1/2" squares

Red fabric: 4-4 1/2" squares
Blue fabric: 2-4 1/2" squares

Construction:
Draw a diagonal line on the back of all the red squares. Matching a red square to each blue square, sew a $1 / 4$ " seam on either side of the line. Repeat with the white $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut on the drawn line and press to the red fabric. Trim finished halfsquare triangle (HST) squares to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

Referencing the diagram at the top, sew all the squares together. Watch the orientation of the red triangles. Press block smooth and measure. The finished block should be 12 1/2"
***Remember your 1/4" seam allowance.***
You can choose to make a complete quilt top by repeating these instructions or you can set this block aside and make a sampler quilt. We look forward to seeing everyone's blocks.
